B. CEO Report

Administration has received notice that the State Talent Investment Agency (TIA) had approved our request for additional funding to expand and improve our current Accelerated Training Just-In-Time Delivery model. The recommended amount of funding by TIA will be \$400,000. Final approval is contingent on action by the State Administrative Board.

In response to a board member request, CEO Oberski has researched the degree of efficiencies gained from the transition of Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works! from a 3-County to a 5-County organization. The transition was part of a major effort around the State that resulted in the consolidation of 25 Michigan Works! Agencies (MWAs) into 16 MWAs. Our growth from 3 to 5 Counties resulted from the dissolution of the 4-County Central Area MWA. Two of its Counties became part of West Michigan Works! and 2 (Gratiot and Isabella) became part of Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works!. Based on discussions with former Directors of Central Area Michigan Works!, that MWA had a large administrative staff because it conducted functions in addition to Michigan Works! programs (eg: they operated a Community Action Agency and a charter school). However they estimated that their administrative staff supported by Michigan Works! funds was about 6 people. About half of those administrative staff positions (ie. 3) were eliminated due to consolidation with Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works!. In comparison, Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works! has added only 1 new staff position: Contract Manager/Monitor.

Due to the holidays, the November and December board meetings are scheduled for the second Monday of the month rather than the fourth Monday. Two board members have noted that they will not be able to attend those meetings. Administration will poll board members to see if other dates might work better.
