Saginaw ISD and Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works! were recommending that the top 5 career clusters be changed to:

- 1. Health Science
- 2. Manufacturing
- 3. Architecture and Construction
- 4. Education and Training
- 5. Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security.

This recommendation was based on review of relevant labor market information, the Regional Workforce Plan adopted by Region 7B Michigan Works! and Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works!, and the WIOA Occupations in Demand identified by those Michigan Works! Agencies.
